*Biography:*

**Lenore Terr, M.D.**, Clinical Professor of Psychiatry at the University of California, San Francisco, School of Medicine is one of the world's pioneers in the study of traumatized children. While doing a number of landmark field studies on trauma with the Chowchilla kidnap victims, the survivors of the Columbine High School shootout, and the kids who witnessed the explosion of the spacecraft *Challenger*, Dr. Terr has also been seeing children in her office and watching them improve. *Magical Moments of Change*, a book she just published, tells how and why they actually improve.

Dr. Terr has been acknowledged through numerous honors and awards, including the American Psychiatric Association's Child Psychiatry Research Award. She is also a distinguished author of *Too Scared to Cry*, *Unchained Memories*, and *Beyond Love and Work*.
